Trend sports such as New School, Ski Fox and Snow Bike are also included







Bambinis (3 years)

- Course start: 10:00 am or 01:00 pm, daily excluding Saturdays
- Meeting point: in the Children's World of the Ski School Arlberg - St. Anton (opposite Gampen chairlift – at the green Hoppl-flag in the children's area).
- Beginners' course: SUN and MON
- Minimum participants: 5 children per group
- Full day program Combinaton of fun and snow:
 4 hours daily from 10:00 to 12:00 and 13:00 to 15:00
- Morning program Outdoor programme (without ski): 2 hours daily from 10:00 to 12:00
- Afternoon Bambini skicourse (with Ski):
 2 hours daily from 13:00 to 15:00

Minis (4 years)

- Course start: 10:00 am, daily excluding Saturdays;
- Meeting point: in the Children's World of the Ski School Arlberg - St. Anton (opposite Gampen chairlift – at the green Hoppl-flag in the children's area) and in Nasserein (at the green Hoppl-flag in the children's area)
- Beginners' course: SUN and MON
- Grouping according to the children's abilities: 10:00 am at the relevant assembly points
- Minimum participants: 5 children per group

Juniors (5 – 11 years) and Teens (12 – 17 years)

- Course start: 09:30 am, daily excluding Saturdays;
- Meeting point: at the assembly point of the Children's World in St. Anton (opposite the Gampen chairlift) and in Nasserein (opposite the Nassereinbahn).

BAMBINIS

PROGRAMME FOR 3 YEAR OLDS

Our Bambini offer can be booked for children with 3 years as a full-day or half-day programme. (Only in the children's world of the Arlberg ski school in St. Anton - opposite the Gampen 4- chairlift - by the green Hoppl flag in the children's area). (The children must be out of diapers).

Morning: Outdoor programme (10.00 - 12.00) without skis Snowman party, children's carousel, various games with our mascot Hoppl are some of the many highlights in our Bambini programme.

We recommend warm winter clothing with gloves and hat, sunglasses or ski goggles. Dear parents - don't forget cold cream or sun protection!

Afternoon: Bambini skicourse (13:00 - 15:00) Incorporating a balanced mixture of skiing, playing and entertainment, the "ski toddlers" learn how to create their first steps on skis.

Full day programme – Combinaton of fun and snow:

€ 99.— (without lunch) per child/day.

Morning programme — without ski

€ 60.— (without lunch) per child.

Afternoon – Bambini skicourse (with Ski))
